ARCHIVES COMMITTEE

MANDATE: The Archives Committee of London Conference promotes and arranges for the preservation of the historically significant records of the Conference, its Presbyteries and Congregations.

Duties: (See Section 460 of the Manual)

1. To present annually, a budget for the committee's work.
2. To ensure the sorting and cataloguing of material in Conference archives are held in Accordance with professional standards and procedures.
3. To arrange for the gathering of archival materials.
4. To educate regarding appropriate material to be archived and best practices for the preservation of this material.
5. To stimulate interest in the history of churches within Conference, and in the history of the United Church.

COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP: The Committee is made up of one member appointed by each of the eight Presbyteries and from the Conference UCW, as per the Manual, plus three members-at-large.

SKILLS AND GIFTS: Committee members should have an interest and/or experience in archival practice and the history of The United Church of Canada.

EXPECTATIONS & TERM OF OFFICE: Three years, renewable. The Chairperson also represents London Conference on the National Archives and History Committee.

COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP:

The Staff Committee comprises a Chairperson and up to five other people. New members shall be recommended in consultation between the existing members of the committee and the Executive Secretary and then confirmed by the Conference Executive.

This committee will strive for a balanced representation from the Conference including such factors as experience in pastoral relations/oversight; experience in church courts such as Conference President; as well as representation of both male and female, lay and ministry, etc.
