Children at Conference team

MANDATE: The committee is responsible for the design and leadership of the Children At Conference program. This program takes place at the time of the London Conference Annual Meeting. The team meets 3-4 times per year at London Conference Office. People serving on this committee need to have experience in Children’s ministry and a current police records check.

Duties

- To meet and design the Children At Conference program that runs during the Annual Meeting of London Conference. This team is to make sure all the leadership needs are met, e.g. recruiting Camp Staff to act as counsellors for the event.
- To offer a safe environment for children to grow and learn and experience God’s love.

COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP:

- The committee is made up of people who are involved in Children’s Ministry within London Conference.
- The team consists of 5-8 people, each year adding others with the skills needed for the program in May but who are not involved on an ongoing basis with the committee.
- A Co-ordinator is recruited by the Conference Staff person and together they determine the length of commitment.
- The Conference Staff person is a resource person for this committee and supports the event, but is not present in leadership.

SKILLS AND GIFTS:

The skills we look for are:

- A strong commitment to Children’s Ministry and experience with children’s programming.
- Ability to work in a team
- Creative
- Good sense of humour
- People with experience and skill in leading – games, music, crafts, drama, puppetry, story-telling, to name a few
- A sense of the larger church
- Commitment and follow through

EXPECTATIONS & TERM OF OFFICE: Each year the team is recruited so people are welcome to apply by August 30th of each year and they will be contacted in September. The Annual Meeting is held at the end of May and the person will need to be available for the weekend.
