## **Fairfield Museum Committee**

**MANDATE:** The Fairfield Museum Committee of London Conference is tasked with caring for, developing and improving the Fairfield site, and the artifacts in its possession, in accordance with long range plans developed by the Committee and approved by London Conference.

**COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP:** This is a volunteer committee made up of people who have taken an active interest in Fairfield Museum. They often represent some interested constituency but are not there only because of that representation. The volunteer's term is defined by their interest and when life interests change they will leave the committee, but from time to time, new people will discover Fairfield Museum and come on board. A chairperson is elected annually. As well, there are five defined positions on this committee: The Curator of Fairfield Museum is a corresponding member; The Executive Secretary of London Conference is the Treasurer; and three positions are reserved for members of the Delaware of the Thames First Nation. The Committee presents its membership annually to London Conference in January of each year.

**SKILLS AND GIFTS:** Committee members should have an interest in the development and improvement of Fairfield Museum of London Conference.

**EXPECTATIONS & TERM OF OFFICE:** There are a minimum of four meetings per year and participation in some aspect of the life of Fairfield Museum is expected in order to maintain volunteer status.
