Grand River Spiritual and Educational Resources London Conference Representatives

MANDATE: Grand River Spiritual and Educational Resources (Bookstore), located at Five Oaks, was incorporated in 2004. It operates with the support of five Conferences – Manitou, Bay of Quinte, Toronto, Hamilton and London. As well as providing books and study resources and being a link to UCRD, the bookstore is the central Canada outlet for AVEL, the United Church of Canada's video and DVD lending library.

Board members provide oversight over the ministry of the bookstore and its financial health as well as supervision of the Director of the bookstore

COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP: The London Conference representatives to the Grand River bookstore consist of one member designated by the Conference to be a member of the Board of Directors, plus two “members” to represent the Conference at the Annual General Meeting.

SKILLS AND GIFTS: All committee members should be actively involved in a local United Church congregation. An interest in lay education in the Conference along with a basic understanding of AVEL and an appreciation for the bookstore as a resource within the United Church would be of value.

EXPECTATIONS & TERM OF OFFICE: For the member of the Board of Directors, there are 3 meetings per year. Board meetings are held in April and October, and the Annual General Meeting (AGM) is held during the first half of November. A report of the operations of the Grand River Bookstore should be made annually to the Conference Executive

The London Conference “members” are expected to represent London Conference at the AGM in November.

The term of appointment is three (3) years. There is the option of re-appointment for a second term.
