Incorporated Ministries Committee

MANDATE: To enable London Conference to fulfill the responsibilities of The Manual and The United Church of Canada's policies on incorporated ministries;

- To support and celebrate incorporated ministries;
- To mentor best practices for incorporated ministries;
- To safeguard the name and assets of The United Church of Canada

Responsibilities:

- To assist corporations with meeting requirements for compliance with The United Church of Canada requirements;
- To recommend policies to the Executive, e.g. insurance, review of financial data, Board membership, and indebtedness;
- To review required submissions;
- To recommend action to the Executive re corporations.

COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP:

A representative from each of the different types of corporations: camping, extension councils, housing ministries, and outreach ministries

Staff Resource: Secretary to Incorporated Ministries, Consultant, Executive Secretary

Meetings: The Committee will normally meet two times per year: in the fall with a focus on policy and in the spring with one on workshop planning. Oversight duties will be on the agenda for each meeting.

Reporting: The Committee on Incorporated Ministries is a Committee of the Division of Finance and Administration and reports to the London Conference Executive through the Division and the Executive Secretary

SKILLS AND GIFTS:

- Commitment to the ministries undertaken by incorporated ministries and to fostering their connection with The United Church of Canada;
- Attention to detail
- Experience with an incorporated ministry

TERM OF OFFICE:

Committee members serve for a three year term, renewable once
