London Conference Youth Forum Committee

MANDATE: The committee meets to provide design and leadership for Youth Forum which takes place in April of each year. The committee ensures that a brochure and information is sent to all participants from the previous year and is sent out to all congregations through the London Conference Office mailing in January. They also make this available through the London Conference website.

COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP: The committee consists of Youth Forum Delegates from the last Annual Meeting - one from each of the eight Presbyteries. These young people are chosen by the Adult Advisors and staff person, taking into consideration a balance of age, gender and experience. Each year a President and President Elect are elected at Youth Forum. The Committee is resourced by two Adult Advisors and a London Conference Staff person.

SKILLS AND GIFTS:

EXPECTATIONS & TERM OF OFFICE:

- The term for each member of the committee is one year.
- The President and President Elect have two-year terms.
- The Adult Advisors determine with the staff person their involvement; only one of the Adult Advisors will change at any one time.
